Truth we can stand on from Romans 8: 28-34

- 28 God works good in EVERY circumstance
- 29 God chose me to be shaped to look like Jesus
- 30 God did the work of forgiving & walking me ahead in this life
- 31 God is for me... no enemy can defeat Him
- 32 God will graciously give me whatever I need
- 33 God is not condemning me
- 34 God the Son, Jesus, is praying for me constantly

Antidotes to the victim mindset that move you toward an "overcomer attitude"

- Celebrate when others succeed and experience blessing (Rom. 12:15)
 Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.
- Honor others as often as possible (Rom. 12:10)
 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.
- Recall inventory & celebrate the things God has accomplished (1 Sam.12:24)
 But be sure to fear the LORD and serve him faithfully with all your heart; consider what great things he has done for you.
- Thanking God for what He has done, and more importantly, for what He will do on your behalf in the future (1 Th. 5:18)
 Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- Praying with faith for not only God's provision (which he says he will be faithful in) but also asking God to bless over and above the minimum (Jas. 1:5-8)
 If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.
- Practice generosity with no strings attached or expectation that the other person will "give back" (1 Tim. 6:18)
 Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share.
